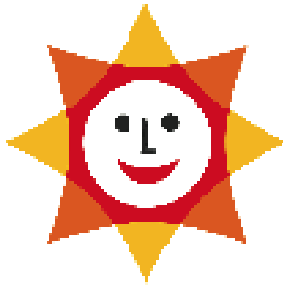

The Belmont Co-op is committed to providing a nurturing learning community and strives to create a seamless experience between school and home for the children. Parents participate in the facets of school life that strengthen the experience for their child and also help the school run effectively.

Families are required to participate in the following ways:

- **Attend a mandatory parent orientation/training in the fall**
- **Serve as a parent helper in the classroom of their child (min. 1 day/month)**
Parent helping responsibilities include:
 - Provide a nut-free snack of 2-3 items for the entire class
 - Assist teachers with day's planned activities
 - Clean classroom at end of the day
- **Participate on a school-wide committee or be responsible for a specific task**
Examples of committee and task responsibilities:
 - Admissions Committee
 - Fundraising Committee
 - Hospitality Committee
 - Weekly Laundry
 - Indoor Maintenance

In addition, parents are always encouraged to share a talent, initiate a special project, accompany the class on field trips, or contribute to the class in a way that contributes positively to the preschool experience.
